- *18/00351 Erection of a pitched roof extension over ground floor bay window to side at Mill House, Atwick Road, Hornsea
- *18/00279 T1 - Young multi stemmed sycamore x 4 stems forming part of self seeded tree line on the boundary to the rear of the property. T2 - Young ash forming part of self seeded tree line on the boundary to the rear of the property T3 - x10 young sycamores, forming part of self seeded tree line on the boundary to the rear of the property The trees are to be removed from the boundary as all the trees are poor/weak specimens, the majority of which have swallowed a chain link fence in to the main stems at Farberry Seaton Road Hornsea
- 18/00449 T1 Sycamore crown lifting of up to 6m of lower limbs/branches to make the tree more aesthetically pleasing and to allow more light in to the garden at White Tree, 1 Northumberland Avenue, Hornsea

T2 Corsican Pine to remove the 2 larger limbs which are overhanging the private lane on Football Green to reduce the weight and risk of potential failure at Moresco, Football Green, Hornsea
