- *18/02292 T1 Oak to remove large limb overhanging the property due to the potential risk of structural damage to the property at 1 Hall Garth Court, Market Place, Hornsea
- 18/02217 T1 – Mature Sycamore to crown lift by approx 4-5m removing lower limbs which are encroaching on immediate structures (garages) this is due to the concern of heavy limbs failing causing structural damage and also to allow more light in to the immediate area
- 18/02290 T1 – Beech to crown lift by approx 6m and crown thin by up to 15% to alleviate the heavy shade that the tree is currently creating
- 18/00933 Erection of 2 semi detached dwellings (Amended plans) at Land East of 3 the Crescent, Hornsea
- 18/02289 T1 Apple tree to section fell due to the tree being close to the property, blocking out light and it's poor specimen. T2 Lawson cypress to reduce by approx 3m as the tree is outgrowing its position. T3 Holly to crown reduce by 2m as the tree has outgrown its position to maintain a manageable height. T4 Ash to section fell due to the tree being in close proximity to the boundary wall potentially causing structural damage and the tree is a poor specimen. T5 Purple leaved plum to reduce by 1m; the tree has outgrown its position within the garden. T6 Dogwood to remove, poor specimen which has become extremely leggy and has no significant value to the surrounding area. T7 Cherry to crown thin 10-15% and crown lift to remove lower branches which are causing an obstruction as head height at Ristonville, 29 Burton Road, Hornsea
