- iii) Cllr B Y Jefferson reported that speed data collection devices have been installed on Southgate and are being monitored for clarity
- iv) Cllr B Y Jefferson confirmed that flood alleviation work on Hornsea Burton Road is now completed and that work at The Crescent should be finished in the near future, a replacement bench will be installed on Hornsea Burton Road
- v) Cllr B Y Jefferson confirmed that the “Murmeration” is now back in place and the roundabout outside Tesco has been cleaned
- vi) Cllr B Y Jefferson reported that Hornsea is now on a list for work on coastal road resurfacing
