3 **Skate park - litter deterrence**

Cllr A Robinson spoke to members regarding complaints about litter around the skate park; as a result children at the youth club want to play their part in keeping the area tidy and have suggested they design Anti-Litter posters. The Youth Club have requested 2 things from the council 1) the winners are presented with their prize at a forthcoming Town Council meeting and 2) the 2 best posters designs are professionally copied onto weatherproof boards, and securely fastened to the skate park railings for all to see. It was **APPROVED** that the requests be granted following costings being obtained for the posters.

Cllr A Robinson also spoke about a model being formalised for the advantage of young people the proposal is that a small team (11 to 18 year olds) is set up and will meet formally in the Town Hall to continue the current initiatives and discuss what other activities children want in addition to the existing. An open meeting is to be held for children and parents on Wednesday 18th July at 7pm in the Town Hall with the aim being to choose about 6 delegates to represent Hornsea in identifying what is required to improve Hornsea for young people. **NOTED**

- 4 Hall Garth Park – to consider a request to hold a fun day**
Mr R Prince had requested permission to hold a charity Fun Day in Hall Garth Park on 4th and 5th August, charity donations will be made to Hornsea Inshore Rescue Boat. It was **APPROVED** that the request be granted provided all the necessary documentations are in place.
- 5 Southgate Cemetery**
Cllr K Nicholson reported that a member of the public had spoke to him regarding the condition of Southgate Cemetery, he had contacted the Town Clerk regarding this matter who informed him that the cemetery to all intents is a “closed” cemetery, it has been designated as a semi-wildlife area and is intentionally left slightly more unkept to encourage wildlife inhabitants. Cllr Nicholson did say that since speaking to the Clerk things had improved. **NOTED**
