4 Benches

Following a discussion regarding the painting of benches within Mereside Play Area it was **APPROVED** that the benches would be painted in Red and Blue to match the equipment already sited and that the future maintenance and upkeep would be HUG's responsibility.

5 Bandstand Concerts

Hornsea Lions had offered Hornsea Town Council funding to provide additional band concerts in Memorial Gardens during 2020. The Deputy Clerk informed members that the workforce had been approached regarding the additional weekend work but they felt that they did not want to commit to any further events during the summer months. It was **APPROVED** that a) Cllr's R Andrew, S Prescott and T Bunch would be prepared to set up for the additional concerts and that b) a letter of thanks be sent to the Hornsea Lions for their kind offer.

6 Use of Elim Gardens

The Park Residential Care Home had sent a request in to the Town Hall for the use of Elim Gardens to hold an open day event in September around the 16th to raise funds for the new step down unit. It was **APPROVED** that the request be granted but that more notice must be given for any future events they wish to hold.

7 No Smoking in Play Areas

Cllr T Bunch spoke to members regarding signage being placed in the children's play areas to prevent people from smoking in these locations, after discussion it was **APPROVED** that a polite notice would be erected within all the play areas asking people to refrain from smoking.

8 Classic Car Show

A request had been received from Hornsea Foundation to hold a Classic Car Show in Hall Garth Park on Sunday 12th July 2020 between the hours of 10am to 4pm. It was **APPROVED** that the request be granted.

9 Hornsea Biker Event

A request had been received from Hornsea Biker Event to hold the Hornsea Biker Event in Hall Garth Park from Saturday 15th August up to and including Sunday 16th August 2020, the hours would be from 1pm on Saturday the 15th to 11.30pm on Sunday the 16th. It was **APPROVED** that the request be granted, but that no overnight stay would be allowed.

10 Plastic Free Hornsea

Cllr J Kemp brought members up to date with Plastic Free Hornsea; members were shown photographs of the signage that is proposed to go on the notice boards at Hall Garth Park and the Willows. **APPROVED**

- 19/02846 Outline – Erection of a dwelling (all matters reserved) at Land South West of 15 Queens Gardens, Hornsea
Recommended Refusal
Would have a detrimental effect on the host building
Not in keeping with the existing properties in a Conservation Area
Access and Egress
Would set an unfortunate precedence for backland development in that area
- 19/02539 Erection of timber outbuilding at rear and 1.8m high timber fence to front (retrospective application) and erection of timber outbuilding at rear at 22A Cheyne Walk, Hornsea
Recommended Refusal
Conflict with the character of the area
Over development
Refusal of the additional building
- 19/02541 Erection of front bay extension to front, construction of dormer window to front and rear to allow for loft conversion and erection of a single storey extension to rear with balcony at 18 Marine Drive, Hornsea
Recommended Refusal
Dormer window overlooking adjoining properties
Conflict with the character of the area
Poor relationship with adjoining buildings
- 19/02560 Conversion of existing stables to form two holiday cottages, with associated parking and garden areas at Eastfield Farm, Atwick Road, Hornsea
Recommended Approval with the proviso that the wildlife is suitably protected
- 19/03000 Carry out a crown lift to approximately 7m, remove 3 branches which are becoming structurally unsafe at 32 Station Court, Hornsea
