- 19/03553 T1 Corsican Pine – to remove the west facing large lower limb which is heavily weighted and is causing concern for the home owner, the limb also causes excessive shade over a large part of the garden at Towers Close, Hull Road, Hornsea
- 19/03211 Section fell Corsican Pine due to having a very heavy lean over the boundary from Moresco onto Spring Cottage and concern for the structural integrity at Spring Cottage, Football Green, Hornsea
- 19/03302 Crown lift 1 no. Sycamore (T1) to 4m and remove all deadwood due to the tree being in poor condition at Grasmere House, Springbank Avenue, Hornsea
