- \* 19/04271 Fell 1 no. Apple tree (T1) due to the tree being in decline with suspected heartwood rot causing concern for the structural integrity at Hornsea Museum, 11-17 Newbegin, Hornsea – **RESOLVED** support the decision of the ERYC Tree Officer
- 19/03380 Reduce crown by approximately 2m to Cherry tree due to being so leggy and encroaching onto the public path and removal of all deadwood at 2

- St. Bedes, Atwick Road, Hornsea – **RESOLVED** support the decision of the ERYC Tree Officer
- 19/04035 Crown reduce 1 no. Willow tree (T1) by approximately 2-3 metres due to the tree out growing its current position, encroaching on neighbouring properties and causing dense shade; Remove large limb from 1 no. Ash tree (T2) due to limb encroaching over the garage and remove the branches on the adjacent side of the tree to rebalance the crown; Crown reduction of 1 no. cherry tree (T3) by 1 metre; remove 1 no. Cherry tree (T4) due to close proximity to the property at Sunfield House, Westwood Avenue, Hornsea – **RESOLVED** support the decision of the ERYC Tree Officer
- 19/03980 Reduce by 50% 3 no. Conifer trees due to overgrown branches causing instability at 15 Burton Road, Hornsea – **RESOLVED** support the decision of the ERYC Tree Officer
